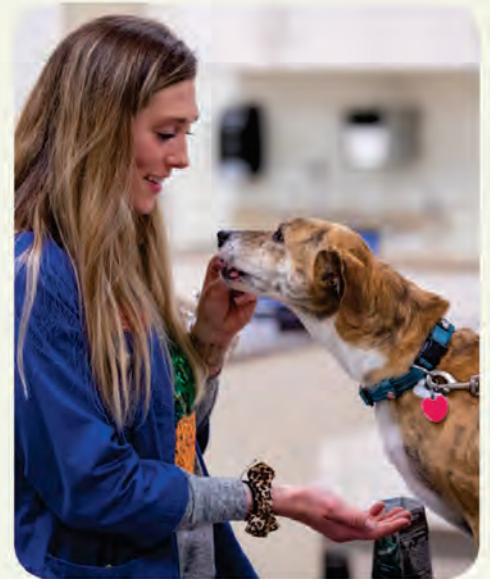

Associate Veterinarian Position

Nodaway Veterinary Clinic, Inc., a multi-doctor, mixed animal practice has an immediate opening for an Associate Veterinarian. The practice is approximately 50% food animal and 50% companion animal/equine. We are looking to add an associate to our team of doctors who has an interest in practicing mixed animal medicine and/or an associate who wants to practice with an emphasis in companion animal medicine.

We are a cow/calf driven practice with an excellent food animal/equine haul-in facility. Theriogenology is an important component of our practice. We provide bovine pregnancy checking both manually and by ultrasound, and do bull semen evaluations (BSE), and perform bovine artificial insemination (AI). Our clinic also performs both fresh and frozen semen equine artificial insemination, as well as Progesterone testing and canine surgical artificial insemination.

Our collaborative, fast-paced clinic is located in a friendly Northwest Missouri community with a Division II University offering a unique blend of athletic and cultural events. Our community has a recreational lake and park with exceptional fishing, equestrian RV park, camping, hiking, and boating. There is also an 18-hole golf course with an additional 9-hole short junior/executive course and putting green on sight.

Maryville, Missouri is located approximately 40 minutes North of St. Joseph, Missouri, 1½hours North of Kansas City, Missouri, and within 2 hours of Des Moines, Iowa and Omaha, Nebraska.

Our veterinarians and staff have been serving Maryville, Northwest Missouri, and Southwest Iowa with professional veterinary care for over 50 years. The food animal/equine haul-in facility has an inside working hydraulic chute, hydraulic tilt table, and indoor livestock pens. There are three portable chutes, two of which have scales. The haul-in facility is also equipped with equine stocks and separate equine surgery room, power float, and horse stalls. Ambulatory truck and inventory are provided. The staff is knowledgeable and friendly. Preceptorships/Externships are welcomed and encouraged as well as working job interviews. Competitive compensation and benefit package offered.

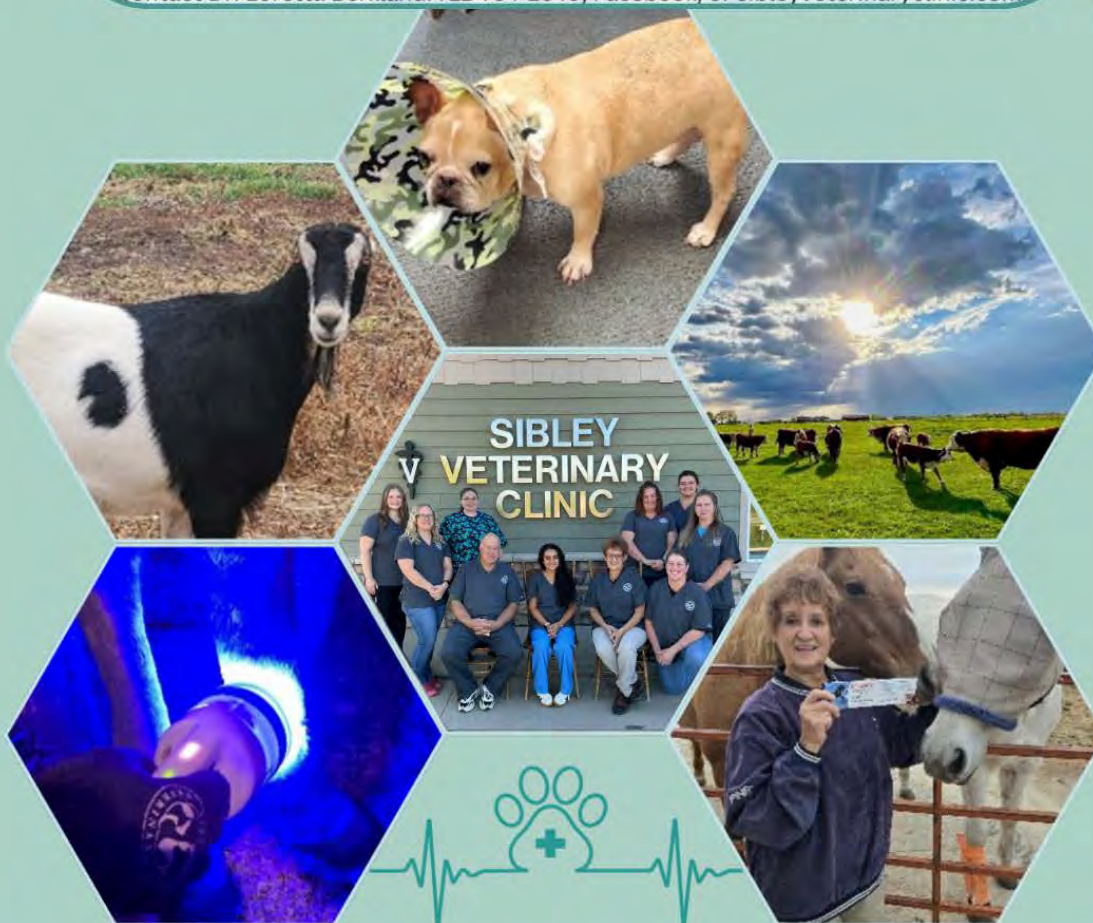
